## Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital Brighton

In June of 2007, the new Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital in Brighton was opened after three years in construction.

The new 15,400m<sup>2</sup> facility, built by Kajima Construction for the Brighton and Sussex University Hospitals NHS Trust at a cost of £37M, has attracted universal acclaim, recently winning a prestigious international award at the Design and Health Fifth World Congress Exhibition in Glasgow.
